

**GORCHYMYN CEFNFFORDD YR A477
(SANCLÉR, SIR GAERFYRDDIN I DDOC
PENFRO, SIR BENFRO) (CYFYNGIADAU
CYFLYMDER DROS DRO A DIM
GODDIWEDDYD) 2024**

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi gwneud Gorchymyn o dan adran 14 o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrd 1984. Mae angen y Gorchymyn er mwyn gwneud gwaith ar gefnffordd yr A477, neu gerllaw iddi, rhwng Sanclér, Sir Gaerfyrddin a Doc Penfro, Sir Benfro.

Effaith y Gorchymyn yw gosod terfyn cyflymder o naill ai 40 mya neu 10 mya a gwahardd goddiweddyyd ar y darn o gefnffordd yr A477 sy'n ymestyn o ganolbwyt ei chyffordd â Chylchfan Sanclér hyd at ei chyffordd â Chylchfan Waterloo, Doc Penfro, gan gynnwys system gylchu'r gylchfan honno. Disgwylir i'r terfyn cyflymder o 10 mya fod yn gymwys yn ystod gwaith confoi.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar 5 Mawrth 2024. Disgwylir y bydd y cyfyngiadau a'r gwaharddiad dros dro yn weithredol o 00:01 o'r gloch ar 5 Mawrth hyd 23:59 o'r gloch ar 18 Mawrth 2024 neu hyd nes y caiff yr arwyddion traffig dros dro eu symud ymaith yn barhaol.

Dim ond yn ystod y dyddiadau a bennir uchod y disgwylir i'r Gorchymyn fod yn weithredol. Er hynny, bydd yn parhau'n ddilys am gyfnod o 18 mis ar y mwyaf rhag ofn y bydd angen ailamserlennu'r gwaith neu wneud gwaith canlyniadol neu waith arall. Bydd hysbysiad am unrhyw newidiadau i'r amseroedd a'r dyddiadau yn cael ei arddangos cyn dechrau unrhyw waith a ailamserlennir.

**THE A477 TRUNK ROAD (ST CLEARS,
CARMARTHENSHIRE TO PEMBROKE DOCK,
PEMBROKESHIRE) (TEMPORARY SPEED
RESTRICTIONS & NO OVERTAKING) ORDER
2024**

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which is necessary to undertake works on or near the A477 trunk road between St Clears, Carmarthenshire and Pembroke Dock, Pembrokeshire.

The effect of the Order is to temporarily impose either a 40 mph or 10 mph speed limit and prohibit overtaking on the length of the A477 trunk road that extends from the centre-point of its junction with St Clears Roundabout to its junction with, and including the gyratory of, Waterloo Roundabout, Pembroke Dock. The 10 mph speed limit is expected to apply during convoy working.

The Order comes into force on 5 March 2024. The temporary restrictions and prohibition are expected to operate from 00:01 hours on 5 March until 23:59 hours on 18 March 2024 or until the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Although the Order is only expected to operate during the dates specified above it will remain valid for a maximum period of 18 months, as a contingency, should the work need to be rescheduled or consequential or other work is required. Notice of any changes to times and dates will be displayed before any rescheduled work begins.
