## **ATISN 20128 Climate change related capital projects**

### **Information requested**

Thank you for your request which I received on 25<sup>th</sup> January 2024. You asked for:

An itemised breakdown - by project title - of the planned spend of £1.6 Billion on climate change related capital projects in Wales.

### **Our response**

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you require is not held by the Welsh Government. Annual Budgets are not allocated on a project basis which grants the budget holders agility in response to matters arising in year.

Whilst I cannot provide information in the requested format, you may find the following publications useful:

- The Budget Expenditure Lines (BEL) supporting the Draft Budget, specifically, rows 402 to 463 of the "BEL\_Tables" tab which provides an analysis of the Capital budget allocated to the Climate Change Main Expenditure Group (MEG) – available here: <https://www.gov.wales/sites/default/files/publications/2023-12/2024-2025-budget-expenditure-lines.ods>
- Wales infrastructure investment strategy project pipeline December 2022, which will give an indication of the projects that are still ongoing into 24/25.
