Your request

- 1. What is the total amount of tax payers money that the WAG has given Sustrans up to and including the current financial year?
- 2. Has that funding been paid directly to Sustrans or through an Agent.?
- 3. Who has been responsible for oversight to ensure that tax payers money has been properly spent.?
- 4. Have all the projects the tax payer has contributed to been subjected to competitive tender.?
- 5. Has any taxpayers money gone towards staffing costs in the Size of Wales Charity?
- 6. Has Mr Lee Waters had any part in decisions which have resulted in tax payers money being given to Sustrans.? If so did he declare an interest as a former employee of that organization.?

Our Response

I wrote to you on 12 February regarding your request for information. I explained that the request did not provide a sufficiently clear description of the information required for me to identify and locate the information you are seeking. It also explained that without this information I would not be able to process your request any further and suggested ways that you could clarify your request. As I have not received any further correspondence from you regarding this matter, I will not be able to process your request your request on this occasion.
