Thank you for your request which I received on 18 February 2024. You asked for the following information, each for the period 1 April 2023 to 18 February 2024, the date on which you made the request:

1. Individual monthly time claims, including costs, for HCC Board members and Chair.
2. Individual monthly expense claims, including costs, for HCC Board members and Chair.
3. A list of external advisors, consultants and professionals (including legal advisors) engaged by HCC including costs (including any invoices yet to be paid) and outlining the procurement process used, including links to Sell2Wales where appropriate.

Our response

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that:

- the Welsh Government holds some of the information you have requested at items 1 and 2 above. This information is enclosed.
- the information you requested at item 3 above is not held by the Welsh Government. I believe Hybu Cig Cymru holds the information you are seeking.
