Number of existing Active Travel Routes	<p>Insert number and length (if known) of existing active travel routes in your authority:</p> <p>As stated below the total of traffic free routes in Newport at 2014 was 83.30 km. Since 2014 21.8 km of new Active Travel routes and 2km of on road cycle lane have been implemented by the Authority and our current total is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 105 km. of Active Travel routes and• 45km of on road cycle routes.
Baseline data at 2016	<p>Insert original levels of active travel in your authority.</p> <p>Traffic free route cycle and walking in 2014 was 83.30km and on road routes cycle was 43.20km. Between 2014 - 2016 a further 3.1km of routes were implemented by The Authority therefore baseline in 2016 was 86.4km.</p> <p>No user data is available from 2016 as counters were installed on major routes from 2017 onwards.</p>
What data was available in your local authority to record usage?	<p>Automated counters on key routes. Where major projects have been developed traffic counts have been undertaken i.e. for Devon Place footbridge</p>
New data at 2022/21	<p>For current levels of active travel in the please see attached document for comparison</p>
What data will be available to support the next iteration of this report?	<p>Key routes will have counter data which will record the amount of journeys being undertaken. This will either be through a fixed counter or as part of targeted traffic survey/counts.</p> <p>Prior to start on site each potential route will have either a temporary counter or targeted traffic survey/counts undertaken to enable us to monitor increase in usage as routes are built</p>
