# Introduction

On 25 May 2023, the Minister for Climate Change and Minister for Rural Affairs and North Wales announced substantially higher payment rates for woodland creation in Wales, to bring them in line with costs in 2023.

This booklet covers the increased rates and provides an overview of Welsh Government grant funding for woodland creation in Wales available to farmers, other landowners and land managers.

The woodland creation schemes are:

- the Small Grants Woodland Creation scheme for support to plant areas
  of up to 2 hectares;
- the Woodland Creation Planning scheme which helps fund the development of a woodland creation plan by a registered woodland planner;
- the Woodland Creation Grant for larger schemes and those not suitable for the Small Grants scheme.

We have committed funding to these schemes between 2023/2024 and 2024/2025.

The funding will help farmers transition to the proposed Sustainable Farming Scheme (SFS) as trees planted now will count towards the SFS universal action for tree cover on farms. There will be no disadvantage in terms of SFS eligibility for undertaking the planting prior to the scheme starting.

Trees and woodlands planted now will help us create a Wales that is resilient to climate change and rich in plants and wildlife, alongside supporting the sustainable production of food, green jobs and a strong rural economy.



# Which scheme is right for you?



## Small Grants — Woodland Creation Scheme

This scheme supports farmers, other landowners and land managers to plant less than 2 hectares of trees on land which is:

- ✓ Agriculturally improved, or
- ✓ Of low environmental value

This is land shown as an area of low sensitivity on the Woodland Opportunities Map (WOM). Have a look at the Small Grants — Woodland Creation map to see if you are eligible for this scheme.

# **Woodland Creation Planning Scheme**

This scheme provides financial support to obtain professional advice from a Registered Woodland Planner to develop a woodland creation plan for an area of at least 0.25 hectares. If the area is less than 2 hectares in size, it may be possible to apply to the Small Grants — Woodland Creation scheme instead.

# The scheme provides grants of between £1,000 and £5,000 for:

- Development of a woodland creation plan which is UKFS compliant, verified by Natural Resources Wales (NRW) and valid for 5 years
- Professional advice from a Registered Woodland Planner
- 80% of costs of a survey, for example, for priority habitats or bird surveys

#### A Woodland Creation Plan will:

- Deliver your objectives for the area of planting
- Help you create well designed woodlands
- Provide a streamlined process if an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) is needed
- Enable you to apply to grants schemes such as the Woodland Creation Grant and the Woodland Investment Grant (TWIG)

Applications can be made at any time in the year.

## **Woodland Creation Grant**

This grant is the right route for farmers, landowners and land managers interested in creating larger areas of woodland, or smaller areas not eligible under the Small Grants — Woodland Creation Scheme.

#### **Key features include:**



5 woodland creation categories including an option of 1,100 trees/ha for native biodiversity



No loss of Basic Payment Scheme (BPS)



Livestock fencing at increased rate of £8.32/m



12 years of maintenance and premium payments

#### **Funding covers:**



Tree planting



Establishment costs for tree planting



Livestock and deer fencing and gates



12 years maintenance costs front loaded to ensure trees establish



12 years premium payments to compensate for loss of agricultural income

Before applying for the Woodland Creation Grant you must have an approved woodland creation plan in place, via the Woodland Creation Planning Scheme, which complies with the UKFS. The application process then allows you to select areas to plant from your approved plan, with a total minimum area of 0.25 hectares which can be comprised of individual 0.1 hectare blocks. There will be windows available throughout the year.
