Thank you for your email of 31 July to Dawn Bowden MS, Deputy Minister for Arts, Sport and Tourism, and other Members of the Senedd, regarding permitted development rights for caravanning and camping. Responsibility for oversight of the planning system in Wales rests with Julie James MS, Minister for Climate Change, and I have been asked to reply on her behalf.

The Welsh Government received a number of concerns about extending the permitted development rights for temporary campsites from residents adjacent to sites, both during the operation of the 56-day allowance following the coronavirus restrictions and in response to the consultation at the start of last year to retain the extended period. Further consideration of the issue is therefore required.

We will consider whether 60 days is appropriate, taking account of consultation responses already received on this issue, when we make the next amendments to permitted development rights. The next set of changes have yet to be scheduled.
