These clinics will be provided at above bases 1- 6

On several occasions we have contacted HIW to clarify if we need to be registered and we have been advised that we do not fall within the scope. Our services have not changed, we do not carry out any invasive surgical procedures. We operate closely within the governance and monitoring frame work of the Local Health boards by reporting to the various CD Lin networks, reporting any Drug related deaths to the statutory panels. Our monitoring is very closely followed by the various NHS monitoring agencies. All the clinicians working within Kaleidoscope carry out annual appraisal validated by the Royal Colleges and GMC.
