I wrote to you on 15 April regarding your request for information.

Your Request

You asked for the following information regarding the A55 Conway Tunnel Construction:

According to the Welsh Governments History of the Conwy Tunnel Page (<u>https://traffic.wales/history-conwy-tunnel</u>) the A55 Conwy road tunnel was constructed for a cost of £102 million.

During the construction phase (between 1988-91), several million tons of earth, silt and sand dredged from the bed of the Conwy estuary were transported and dumped on the salt marsh to the south of the Conwy Bridge. A bunded area was created by the building of a 1-km sea wall of rock armour topped with a clay core bund creating the land on which the RSPB Conwy reserve now sits. I believe the creation of the site was done by Costain-Tarmac under contract to the Welsh Office.

• Please can you tell me what proportion of this £102 million budget was used for this specific purpose (ie. transport of the waste material to its new location as well as path creation and landscaping costs on the site prior to the RSPB leasing the land in 1994). A rough approximation is fine.

Our Response

I can confirm that the Welsh Government does not hold the information you have requested. The tunnel was built between September 1986 and October 1991, and therefore pre-dates our current filing system.
