

GORCHYMYN CEFNFFORDD YR A5 (MAN I'R DE O FETWS-Y-COED, CONWY) (GWAHARDD CERBYDAU SY'N LLETACH NA 3 METR DROS DRO) 2025

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi gwneud Gorchymyn o dan adran 14 o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984. Mae angen y Gorchymyn arfaethedig er mwyn gwneud gwaith ar gefnffordd yr A5 i'r de o Fetws-y-coed, Conwy, neu gerllaw iddi.

Effaith y Gorchymyn yw gwneud y canlynol dros dro gerbydau sy'n lletach na 3 metr rhag mynd ar y darn o'r gefnffordd ym Metws-y-coed sy'n ymestyn o'i chyffordd â'r A470 (Pont Waterloo) i'r de o Fetws-y-coed i gyfeiriad y de hyd at ei chyffordd â'r B4406 i Benmachno.

Y llwybr arall ar gyfer cerbydau yr effeithir arnynt sy'n teithio tua'r de fydd mynd ar yr A5 i Gyffordd 11 o'r A55; yr A55 tua'r gorllewin i Gyffordd 9; yr A487/A470 tua'r de i Drawsfnnydd; yr A4212 i'r Bala; yr A494 tuag at Gorwen a'r A5 tuag at Fetws-y-coed. Bydd cerbydau yr effeithir arnynt sy'n teithio tua'r gogledd yn dilyn y llwybr arall uchod i'r gwrthwyneb.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar 28 Chwefror 2025 a bydd yn weithredol hyd 31 Mawrth 2025 neu pan fydd yr arwyddion traffig dros dro yn cael eu symud ymaith yn barhaol.

Dim ond yn ystod y cyfnod a bennir uchod y disgwylir i'r gwaharddiad dros dro fod yn weithredol. Er hynny, bydd y Gorchymyn yn parhau'n ddilys am gyfnod o 18 mis ar y mwyaf rhag ofn y bydd angen ailamserlennu'r gwaith neu wneud gwaith canlyniadol neu waith arall. Bydd hysbysiad ymlaen llaw am unrhyw newidiadau i'r amseroedd a'r dyddiadau yn cael ei arddangos cyn gwneud unrhyw waith a ailamserlennir.

THE A5 TRUNK ROAD (SOUTH OF BETWS-Y-COED, CONWY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES OVER 3 METRES WIDTH) ORDER 2025

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which is necessary to undertake works on or near the A5 trunk road south of Betws-y-Coed, Conwy.

The effect of the Order is to temporarily prohibit vehicles with a width greater than 3 metres from proceeding on the length of trunk road at Betws-y-Coed that extends from its junction with the A470 (Waterloo Bridge) south of Betws-y-Coed in a southerly direction to its junction with the B4406 to Penmachno.

The alternate route for affected vehicles travelling southbound will be via the A5 to Junction 11 of the A55; the A55 westbound to Junction 9; the A487/A470 southbound to Trawsfynydd; the A4212 to Bala; the A494 towards Corwen and the A5 towards Betws y Coed. Affected vehicles travelling north will follow the above alternative route in reverse.

The Order will come into force on 28 February 2025 and will operate until 31 March 2025 or when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Although the temporary prohibition is only expected to operate during the period specified above the Order will remain valid for a maximum period of 18 months, as a contingency, should the work need to be rescheduled, or consequential or other work is required. Advance notice of any changes to times and dates will be displayed before any rescheduled work.
