- > *1. What the detrimental activities are.*
- > *2. What is being prohibited and/or required including any exemptions.*
- > *3. The area covered.*
- > *4. The consequences of a breach.*
- > *5. The period for which it had effect.*
- > *6. The details of the 6 week public consultation including how many if any members of the public were consulted.*
