**Reference - ATISN 24424 - Maternity Services - Swansea Bay University Health Board**

Thank you for your information request which was received on **21 February 2025**. You have requested the following information:

- 1. Any intelligence / documents / records you hold relating to maternity in Swansea Bay University Health Board since December 2023.*
- 2. Any meeting minutes you have relating to the same since December 2023.*

We can confirm that we hold information that is captured by your request. However, in order to retrieve and extract the information, we would need to review in excess of 600 records, and we have estimated this taking at least 30 hours.

Section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act does not oblige a public authority to comply with a request for information if the authority estimates that the cost of complying with the request would exceed the appropriate limit. Regulation 3 of the Freedom of Information and Data Protection (Appropriate Limit and Fees) Regulations 2004 sets out that the appropriate limit is £600. Regulation 4(4) states that the cost of the time which you expect to spend dealing with the request must be estimated at a rate of £25 per hour. This means that the request would exceed the appropriate limit if complying would take more than 24 hours of work. Therefore, on this basis, we are unable to provide this information as it would exceed the appropriate limit.

You may wish to submit a new request and consider narrowing the scope of your request, for example, by reducing the time period.

Please note that we will not take any additional action in relation to this request. Any further request for information received from you will be logged and handled as a new request.
