Registering for an EIDCymru online account has many advantages, with it you can:


- » Create a movement

- » Complete the Sheep & Goat Annual Inventory


Once registered, log in to your EIDCymru online account, using your username or email address and your password. You will see your dashboard where there are many functions available for you to use.

Create a movement


Within Business Moves – Report sheep that have moved from one holding to another holding within the same business









2 Select 'Report animals leaving'







- Enter individual tag numbers for the moved sheep, the Flock number will appear in the line below to reduce repetition.
 Change the Flock number as required
- Select 'Confirm selected tags' when you have inputted all tag numbers

- Confirm the number of sheep in the 'Animals moving', it should match 'Tags recorded'
- Confirm 'Yes' or 'No' in the FCI section. If you select 'No' you may leave the details section blank as the sheep are not going to slaughter
- Click 'Save and Continue'


