The Joint Call for Proposals between the parties seeks to foster and grow collaborative links between Wales and Québec by:

- promoting sustainable development in each society
- promoting cooperation between research centres and researchers in targeted fields of interest on both sides
- promoting cooperation in economic development in priority areas of mutual interest
- supporting the work of our creative sectors to showcase our respective unique cultural heritages
- favouring a better mutual understanding through the consolidation of networks and sharing of expertise
- to contribute to the diversity of cultural content, to the enhancement of the Québec and Welsh languages, and to their discoverability in the digital environment.

The present call for proposals is open to all sectors in sustainability, research and innovation, and culture. Certain fields will be prioritised but applications will not be limited to those listed below:

Economy, Science and Innovation For example: circular economy, renewable energy, health and life sciences (genomics, medical technologies, biotechnologies, public health), aerospace, emerging technology (artificial intelligence, compound semiconductors, cyber security, quantum technology), critical materials and manufacturing.

Arts and Culture For example: audiovisual, literature and publishing, performing arts, visual and digital arts, music, language collaboration.
