

The following guide explains where you can get the Land and Entitlement data required to complete your Sustainable Farming Scheme (SFS) Ready Reckoner.

This guide provides you with information on where you can find the current known data for your farm. Your claim, and the data used for your SFS Universal Payment in 2026 could be different, especially if circumstances change for your farming business e.g. land change, transfer and lease of entitlements.

- Buildings / yards (ZZ89)
- Hardstanding (ZZ92)
- Roads (ZZ94)
- Tracks (ungrazed) (ZZ97)
- Non-agricultural activities (NO1)

SFS Data Confirmation form 2025

An indicative **Habitat Maintenance Area** and **Woodland Maintenance Area** is available in the SFS Data Confirmation 2025 form or the Summary document if it has already been submitted.

We recommend you check and update the mapped areas of habitat and tree canopy for your farm before completing the Ready Reckoner to ensure the calculation is as accurate as possible.

Please note: In cases where two or more farmers share-graze portions of non-common land (and no share farming agreement exists) the Data Confirmation form will show the total parcel area to each farmer and allow them to update the Habitat and Tree Canopy accordingly.

Therefore, the Habitat and Tree Canopy size totals will show the total amounts within the field parcel and not the specific portion of Habitat and/or Tree canopy at your disposal. It is important to only use the Habitat and/or Tree Canopy total at your disposal when entering details into the Ready Reckoner.





If you have reviewed all parcels, you should use the area shown against the **Total** included habitat across reviewed parcels:




Woodland Maintenance Area


You can get an indicative **Woodland Maintenance Area** from the Tree canopy Size Totals page.

Only Woodland and Tree Canopy areas over 0.1ha is eligible for Woodland Maintenance payments under SFS.

If you have not yet reviewed any parcels, you should use the area shown against: **Total** tree canopy equal to or greater than **0.1ha** in parcels not reviewed.



If you have started reviewing parcels, you should add the areas shown against: **Total tree canopy equal to or greater than 0.1ha in reviewed parcels** and the **Total tree canopy equal to or greater than 0.1ha in parcels not reviewed,** together to give a total area.
