Customer Topic id wants to add his Common Land area to his CPH. At that it couldn't be done as it wasn't a sole grazed the time I informed common. However the applicant has come back to to advise that it is a sole grazed common, as he owns the lower part of CL 126. We requested maps to see if they could throw any light on this for us. I've also got the Common Land Register for Meirionnydd CL 126. The Ownership section does show that the applicant is the owner of part of the common. 'Part of the land comprised in this register unit lying North and West of Line A -B on the register map. The applicant also has Registered Grazing rights, which he exercises at Entry 7, with a 'Right to graze 75 sheep over the land comprised in this register unit BUT not over the area in the SOUTH bounded by the line C – D on the register map. The aera noted as A – B on register map also has a land parcel number attached to it. This is SH8826 6366. This land parcel has never been claimed upon. From what I can get from the register, it looks like this common has restricted rights. 3 entries have the right to graze all of the land apart from the area A -B.

has the right to graze all land apart from land lying south of line C – D.
