## ATISN 24921 - Funding

Thank you for your request which I received on 9 July. You asked for the following information:

A list of charities, not for profit companies, campaign groups, or others who were given grants, or contributions from the Welsh government during the financial years 2022/23, and separately 2023/24.

For the avoidance of doubt, these details should include amounts for any purpose and for any requests made within the UK, or overseas.

## Our response

The information requested is published at the following link: <u>FOI release 24393:</u> Charities funding | GOV.WALES

Welsh Government systems do not separately categorise charities, not for profit companies or campaign groups, we do however categorise entities to which we make payments as 'Third Sector in our finance system. This includes charitable and similar organisations.

A listing of all payments made to Third Sector organisations is included in ATISN 24393 (link above) which includes grant and procured services payments for the periods you have requested.

In addition to the information provided, if you are interested in a particular organisation, information in relation to payments made by the Welsh Government

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
