I followed our normal naming convention of referring to the nearest placename on the OS map. It is a positional reference rather than a statement of ownership, and I would have followed this practice even if the entire stone was on another owner's land. [Redacted – Regulation 13 Personal Data] did not mention the land dispute when I visited, and readily directed me to the neighbour who she told me owned the other part, so this is news to me.

Perhaps it would be most diplomatic to change the name to 'Tai'r-Waun Prehistoric Rock Art, Llanfabon.' I'm content with that if you are.
