Please find attached a new scheduling proposal for your endorsement. This cup-marked stone is a fine new discovery and compares well with other examples across Wales. This particular example is part of a distinct south central Wales group, and other examples are already scheduled (Prehistoric Rock Art on Mynydd Eglwysilan Common / GM628), and two others on Gelligaer Common are to be assessed. It is located on a property boundary, and both owners are aware of the proposed scheduling and supportive. There was a concern that the stone would be disturbed by an access track to a proposed windfarm, but the scheme's archaeological consultants are aware of our scheduling intention and provided reassurances that the access track will be routed away from the stone.

I visited the rock art panel in September, and [Redacted – Regulation 13 Personal Data] visited in December to record the cupules under oblique light at night. [Redacted – Regulation 13 Personal Data] provided a photographic report, and I am content that the monument is in the same condition as when I visited. The scheduled area extends further south than just the rock art panel, as it incorporates a slight but noticeable raised stone-rich platform, which [Redacted – Regulation 13 Personal Data], believes may represent the truncated remains of an associated mound.

[Redacted – Regulation 13 Personal Data], MS took a keen interest in the scheduling of this monument and attended the site visit. [Redacted – Regulation 13 Personal Data], asked to be informed when the monument had been designated.
