- 2. Copies of the grant agreements, contracts, or memoranda of understanding associated with the awards.
- 3. Copies of any business cases, ministerial submissions, or supporting documents used to inform the decision.
- 4. The objectives and expected outcomes linked to the funding.
- 5. Any monitoring or reporting requirements placed on the organisations as part of the funding.

Our response

Information regarding Community Energy Wales funding by the Welsh Government directly in 2025-26 financial year can be found in annex 1.

The grant agreement and contract are part of the grant award letter issued. Where these have been issued, we have shared copies as part of the response to ATISN 25085 sent on the 22 September. Business case covering 2025-26 was also shared in the response to ATISN 25085. There are no memoranda of understanding between Welsh Government and Community Energy Wales.

We have provided a summary of associated Ministerial advice documents in annex 1 and redacted copies are shared with this response for information. Please note any information redacted in the Ministerial advice is redacted as it is not captured in this information request.

All objectives and expected outcomes are detailed in the grant award letters previously shared and these constitute the monitoring points places on the organisation as part of the funding. We provided information in ATISN 25085 on monitoring.
