Subject	Ynni Cymru Capital Grant Scheme - Approval of Projects and a request to transfer money between Energy BELs
100-word summary	The Ynni Cymru £10,000,000 Capital Grant Scheme for Smart Local Energy System (SLES) projects closed for applications on 16 June.
	This advice outlines the Approval Board recommendations to award capital grants to a total of 48 projects which will require a total grant award of £12,906,707.
	This will be funded from the £10,000,000 already allocated to the Ynni Cymru Capital Grant Scheme available in BEL 3775. Approval is required to transfer an additional £2,907,000 from currently unallocated capital available in Green Energy BEL 1280.
Timing	A response if required before the proposed announcement on the funded projects which is provisionally planned for the 15 September.
Recommendation	 The Cabinet Secretary is asked to: Approve the award of grant to projects outlined in Annex to the total value of £12,907,000. This includes approved capital funding for the project of £10,000,000 from Ynni Cymru Capital BEL and £2,907,000 from Green Energy Capital BEL. Approve the transfer of £2,907,000 from The Green Energy Capital BEL 1280 to Ynni Cymru Capital Grants BEL 3775 to allocate capital for all agreed projects under Ynni Cymru, detailed in Annex 2.
