## **ATISN 26210 – Information Request (Crown Estate)**

### **Information requested**

Thank you for your request which I received on 01/10/2025. You asked for:

Correspondence between the Welsh Government and the UK Government on the devolution of the Crown Estate, and the establishment of the Welsh Group on the Crown Estate.

### **Our response**

The information that you requested contains the same request for information associated with a previous request for information processed last year, ATISN 21958, which can be accessed through the following [link](#).

From my preliminary assessment, I can confirm that the same limitations highlighted in the previous response would apply to this request. Therefore, I estimate it will cost more than the appropriate limit set out in the Freedom of Information and Data Protection (Appropriate Limit and Fees) Regulations 2004 to answer your request. The appropriate limit specified for central government is £600. This represents the estimated cost of it taking over 24 hours of time to determine whether we hold the information and to thereafter locate, retrieve and extract it.

Processing this part of the request would therefore require more than 73 hours which is excess of the 24-hour limit. The information is therefore withheld.

### **Next steps**
