Thank you for your complaint which I received on 21 October 2025.

You asked for Welsh Government to conduct an internal review of its response to your original request for details of the UN officials responsible for monitoring UNCRC compliance in Wales.

I have conducted an internal review and uphold the decision that the information you have requested is not held by Welsh Government and that the handling of the request was correct.

I think it is important to clarify that we are not saying the UN does not monitor compliance with the UNCRC, but that we do not hold information on the officials responsible for it.
