I wrote to you on 11 July 2025 regarding your request for information.

You have asked for the following information:

Data on the number of breakdowns for the calendar years 2023 & 2024 on Welsh Motorways and A roads broken down as follows:

- The number of breakdowns per year, per month, per day
- Which months have the most breakdowns reported
- Which day in the week do most breakdowns occur
- Geographical locations of breakdowns
- Which roads do the most breakdowns occur on

Our response:

We hold some data for your request but as advised only on roads for which the Welsh Government are responsible. We are not required to keep information about breakdowns so there is a difference in the detail kept between North/Mid Wales and South Wales.

Annex A contains a table of the information requested from April 2024 to December 2024. As advised in my acknowledgement letter to you information for 2023 and the first three months of 2024 has been released under a previous FoI 19640 and I provided the link to the information.

Next steps

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
