Thank you for your request which I received on 28 October 2025. You asked for:

- All correspondence between the First Minister and the Permanent Secretary on the issue of pre-election access talks for opposition parties.
- The minutes of all cabinet meetings at which the issue of access talks has been discussed.
- All correspondence between previous First Ministers and Permanent Secretaries on the issue of access talks prior to each of the previous Senedd elections.

## Our response

To clarify, we do not hold any formal letters between the Permanent Secretary and the First Minister on this specific issue. Furthermore, in response to your inquiry about formal letters between previous First Ministers and Permanent Secretaries on the topic of access talks, I must inform you that we do not possess any such formal correspondence.
