



Checklist: Sheep & Goat Annual Inventory

This checklist is for assistance only and will NOT be accepted as an inventory return.

The quickest way to complete your inventory is via your EIDCymru account.

If you have not registered for an account you can complete the inventory via the online EIDCymru portal.

What information do I need to complete my annual inventory?

Before you start, please make sure you have the following information to hand:

	The unique 6 digit code printed on your letter/email inviting you to complete the inventory (Only required if you do not have an EIDCymru online account.)				
	Your primary County Parish Holding Number (CPH) in this format 00/000/0000.				
	You will need to have the CPH of each location where you keep sheep and/or goats on 1 December and an accurate count of all your animals on each separate CPH .				
If you need help with finding a common land CPH please email EIDCymru					

For each CPH where sheep and/or goats are present on 1 December, you must accurately record the number of animals in the following categories on your inventory. Below is an example to guide you:

CPH – where sheep are located on 1 December	Number of breeding ewes put to the ram	Number of breeding ewe lambs put to the ram	Number of ewe lambs retained for breeding not put to the ram	Number of fat/store lambs	Number of rams	Number of other sheep (not included in other columns)	Number of goats
