## **ATISN 26410 – Carbon Sequestration in Agricultural Land**

### **Information requested**

Thank you for your request which I received on 24 November 2025. You asked for:

Updated information held by Welsh Government about the amount of carbon sequestered through agricultural land use at a Wales scale.

### **Our response**

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you require is not held by the Welsh Government.

You receive this response, as there is no new information available regarding the amount of carbon sequestered by agricultural land use in Wales, this is still assessed using figures derived from the UK Greenhouse Gas Inventory.

You identify the work of the SFS carbon sequestration panel in your request, the panel did not look at or report on the amounts of carbon sequestered through agricultural land use within Wales. The panel considered the suitability of management actions that have the potential to sequester carbon on agricultural land.

### **Next steps**

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
