Subject: Formal commission for UK IPC cell

As discussed, following the 4 CNO forum meeting today we are seeking to commission the UK IP&C cell to undertake a review of the evidence and guidance. The review is to include the recent IPC guidance issued this week, together with the recent WHO update and evidence from the airborne transmission group in England in order to offer a perspective on whether we need to consider universal enhanced respiratory protection in healthcare settings.

We are also seeking a view on the reasons why we should not adopt the precautionary principle with a view to FFP2 masks for all staff with the exception of where AGPs are undertaken. Given the emerging variants, respiratory and winter viruses and increased staff absences- your expert view would be most welcome to inform our position.
