Request for Information - ATISN 26529

Further to your request for information dated 24 December 2025. You asked for the following information regarding the widening and realignment of the A487 in the 1960s as it pertains to your property at Pentrwyn Garnedd:

Engineering/Technical Drawings
Land Acquisition and Agreements
Drainage Asset Status
Maintenance Records

Our Response

The Welsh Government holds some of the information you have requested. I attached documents relating to the land acquisition and agreements from 1961. There is also a land drainage plan which shows there are gulleys either side of the property and the one to the east is connected beneath the carriageway by a 150mm pipe to an outfall into the river. There is an edge channel in front of the property. From our searches we do not have any as-builts and there is no reference to a clinker bed or filtration system. The last drainage survey was October / December 2023.

However, I have also called for the old records we received from Merioneth CC but they have not yet been received from our remote storage system. When they do if there is any further information relating to your request, I will provide it or advise you there is no further relevant information.

Next Steps
