
Declaration of the end of the Protection Zone and Surveillance Zone (Avian Influenza) near Milford Haven, Pembrokeshire (AIV2025/105) centred on grid reference SM8961808279.

The Chief Veterinary Officer for Wales confirmed the presence of highly pathogenic avian influenza on a premises in Wales.

In accordance with articles 28(1) and 29(1) and (2) of the Avian Influenza and Influenza of Avian Origin in Mammals (Wales) (No 2) Order 2006¹ ("the Order") and having taken account of the criteria set out in article 29(5), the Welsh Ministers declared a Protection Zone and a Surveillance Zone centred on grid reference SM8961808279 at 18:45 on 18 November 2025.

At least 30 days have elapsed since the completion at all infected premises in the Zones declared of the preliminary cleansing and disinfection measures referred to in Part 2 of Schedule 3 to the Order; and a veterinary inquiry has been completed at all premises identified as containing poultry or other captive birds within the Protection Zone.

Pursuant to articles 4(1) and 36(1), (2) and (3) of the Order, the Welsh Ministers hereby declare the end of that Protection Zone and Surveillance Zone.

This ending of the Protection Zone and Surveillance Zone takes effect from 15:00 on 30 January 2026, thereby ending the measures imposed in the 3 kilometre Protection Zone and 10 kilometre Surveillance Zone.

All terms in this Declaration are as defined in the Order.
