Information requested

Thank you for your request which I received on 14 January 2026. You asked for:

All the information and documentation held by the Welsh Government relating to the award of public funding of approximately £900,000 to Gwyr Community Land Trust (also referred to as Gower Community Land Trust).

You specifically requested the following:

1. The name of the funding programme or policy under which the grant was awarded (for example, whether it was awarded under the Land and Buildings Development Fund or any other scheme).
2. The grant award letter, funding agreement, or contract issued to Gwyr Community Land Trust.
3. The eligibility criteria, assessment framework, and guidance documents applied when considering the award.
4. Any internal assessment, appraisal, or approval documentation used to determine the grant award (including scoring or recommendation summaries).
5. Details of any conditions attached to the grant, including monitoring, clawback, planning, or delivery requirements.
6. Confirmation of the dates, amounts paid or committed, and the intended purpose of the funding.

Our response

The information requested is not held by the Welsh Government. The Welsh Government have not provided grant to Gwyr Community Land Trust or Gower Community Land Trust).

There have been previous requests for information, which are similar to your request, and which we believe may be beneficial for you to review. I have attached links to the responses provided.
