Thank you for your request which we received on 4 February 2026. You asked for us to *“provide copies of, or links to, any reports, outputs, or deliverables produced as a result of 'research studies' funding awarded to the following organisations:*

- 1. Miller Research UK Ltd, specifically in relation to payments made on 3 October 2025, 6 October 2025, and 17 October 2025; and*
- 2. Alma Economics Ltd, specifically in relation to the payment made on 29 October 2025.*

If full reports are not held, please provide any available documentation evidencing the research outputs associated with these payments.”

ATISN 26667 refers to the payment made to Miller Research UK Ltd on 6 October 2025. The information relating to the other payments, which was requested as part of your initial request will be responded to within another letter.

Our response

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, we have established that the information you require is not held by the Welsh Government currently.

The payment made to Miller Research UK Ltd on 6 October 2025 relates to research that is being conducted on behalf of the Welsh Government. This research will be completed and published at a future date in March 2026.
