ATISN 26590 – Late payments

In your correspondence dated 24 February, it was confirmed the invoice date data was required, and preferable the invoice received dates. As a result, 42,906 transactions are requested for released.

Our response

Based on your information request dated 24 February, 42,906 transactions were confirmed as required, based on invoice date. The data was split into two phases for publication.

Phase 1 cleared 31,160 transactions for publication, which we sent to you on 16 March.

Phase 2 has cleared the remaining 11,746 transactions. Any transactions identified as commercially sensitive during the organisational review, have been redacted.

Next steps

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
