Request for Information - ATISN 26651

Thank you for your request for information which I received on 3 February. Your request has been logged under reference ATISN 26651. You have asked for the following information relating to the Tai ar y Cyd Pattern Book 2024/25:

1. The total project expenditure, financial remittance or remuneration in regard to the research and final draft publication and/or procurement contract costs paid to Stride Treglown Architects (including all expenses) by the office or and /or the Cabinet Secretary for Housing and Local Government.

Our Response:

The Welsh Government did not provide any funding directly to, or procure under contract any services from, Stride Treglown Architects. The Tai ar y Cyd project is a collaboration between 25 social landlords in Wales who have collectively funded the pattern book developed by Stride Treglown Architects.

In March 2024, the then Minister for Climate Change agreed to provide a £100,000 contribution toward the Tai ar y Cyd project to assist the social landlords in the development of pattern book homes. Those funds may have been used to remunerate Stride Treglown Architects for services provided in the development of the pattern book and which we believe falls within scope of your request for information. We are unable to provide a more detailed response on the total project expenditure.
