Request for Information - ATISN 26689

Thank you for your request for information which I received on the 10 February 2026. Further to your request in January (ATISN 26529) you have asked for follow up information regarding drainage on the A487 at Pentwyn Garnedd relating to the information on our Highway Asset Drainage Management System and in particular a node which shows the drainage in question.

You asked for:

1. The **Unique Asset ID** for this node.
2. The **As-Built drawings** associated with this specific Asset ID.
3. The **Maintenance History** recorded for this node over the last 10 years.

This is an interim update on your request. The green node point is not the marker for the pipe which goes under the road – that is on the road beyond your property.

The relevant asset references for the Gully and Outlet are SH6439_2899a and SH6439_2898a. The pipe runs between these two asset references but does not have its own asset reference.

There have been many changes in authorities over the past 60 years and we are unable to locate As-Built drawings.

There was confusion about the information I asked our Trunk Road Agents for with regards to maintenance history – the green node point was used which is for a kerb point not the gully and outlet so I have requested the records for those two asset references. I will provide the information by Friday 20 March.

Next Steps
