Request for Information - ATISN 26747

Thank you for your request for information which I received on 23 February. Your request has been logged under reference ATISN 26747. You have asked for the following information relating to Cardiff Airport:

1. The number of structural renovation, refurbishment or expansion projects carried out at Cardiff Airport during the 2024 to 2025 financial year.
2. The number of structural renovation, refurbishment, or expansion projects currently underway or scheduled for completion during the 2025 to 2026 financial year.
3. A high-level summary of the general nature of these works, for example terminal refurbishment, infrastructure upgrades, operational reconfiguration, extension works or new build.
4. The names of principal contractors appointed to deliver renovation or expansion projects at Cardiff Airport since January 2024.
5. The types of temporary or semi-permanent partitioning or hoarding systems typically used during renovation or construction works at Cardiff Airport, for example modular walling systems, stud partitioning, solid panel hoarding or temporary screening systems.
6. Whether responsibility for specifying and approving temporary partitioning systems during construction works sits primarily with:
 - a. the Welsh Government,
 - b. Cardiff International Airport Limited, or
 - c. the appointed contractor.
7. If any of the requested information is already publicly available, please provide a link to the relevant source.

Our Response:

The Welsh Government does not hold any of the information you have requested.

Cardiff Airport is a wholly owned subsidiary of the Welsh Government, operated at arms-length as a private limited company. It operates in an independent and commercial manner and is responsible for procuring any construction works at the airport.
