

**GORCHYMYN CEFNFFORDD YR A483
(CILMERI, POWYS) (GWAHARDD CERBYDAU
DROS DRO) 2026**

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi gwneud Gorchymyn o dan adran 14 o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984. Mae angen y Gorchymyn er mwyn gwneud gwaith ar gefnffordd yr A483, neu gerllaw iddi, yng Nghilmeri, Powys.

Effaith y Gorchymyn yw gwahardd dros dro bob cerbyd, ac eithrio'r rhai a ddefnyddir gan y gwasanaethau brys neu ar gyfer y gwaith, rhag mynd ar y darn o'r gefnffordd sy'n ymestyn o ganolbwynt ei chyffordd â'r ffordd fynediad i Comyn Cottage hyd at bwynt 300 o fetrau i'r dwyrain o ganolbwynt ei chyffordd â'r ffordd fynediad i'r eiddo o'r enw Caeau.

Y llwybr arall ar gyfer traffig sy'n teithio tua'r dwyrain yw mynd ar yr A483 tua'r de-orllewin i Lanymddyfri, yr A40 tua'r dwyrain i Aberhonddu a'r A470 tua'r gogledd i Lanfair-ym-Muallt i ailymuno â'r A483: i'r gwrthwyneb ar gyfer cerbydau sy'n teithio tua'r gorllewin.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar 16 Mawrth 2026. Disgwylir y bydd y gwaharddiad dros dro yn weithredol yn ysbeidiol rhwng 19:00 o'r gloch ar 16 Mawrth a 07:00 o'r gloch ar 28 Mawrth 2026, neu hyd nes y caiff yr arwyddion traffig dros dro eu symud ymaith yn barhaol.

Dim ond yn ystod y cyfnod a bennir uchod y disgwylir i'r Gorchymyn fod yn weithredol. Er hynny, bydd yn parhau'n ddilys am gyfnod o 18 mis ar y mwyaf rhag ofn y bydd angen ailamserlennu'r gwaith neu wneud gwaith canlyniadol neu waith arall. Bydd hysbysiad am unrhyw newidiadau i'r amseroedd a'r dyddiadau yn cael ei arddangos cyn gwneud unrhyw waith a ailamserlennir.

**THE A483 TRUNK ROAD (CILMERY, POWYS)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES)
ORDER 2026**

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which is necessary to undertake works on or near the A483 trunk road at Cilmeri, Powys.

The effect of the Order is to temporarily prohibit all vehicles, other than those being used by the emergency services or for the works, from proceeding on the length of the trunk road that extends from the centre-point of its junction with the access road to Comyn Cottage to a point 300 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with the access road to the property known as Caeau.

The alternative route for eastbound traffic is via the south-westbound A483 to Llandovery, eastbound A40 to Brecon and northbound A470 to Builth Wells to rejoin the A483: vice versa for westbound vehicles.

The Order comes into force on 16 March 2026. The temporary prohibition is expected to operate intermittently from 19:00 hours on 16 March until 07:00 hours on 28 March 2026, or until the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Although the Order is only expected to be in force during the period specified above, it will remain valid for a maximum period of 18 months, as a contingency, should the work need to be rescheduled or consequential or other work is required. Notice of any changes to times and dates will be displayed before any rescheduled work begins.
