Request for Information - ATISN 26810

Further to your request for information of 19 March. You asked for information about the A483 trunk road between Welshpool and Newtown. Specifically, you requested the following information for the most recent completed 5 calendar years (2021,2022, 2023,2024,2025):

1. Copies of any completed Road Safety Audits (Stage 3 or Stage 4) or formal post-implementation safety reviews relating specifically to this section.
2. Details of any speed surveys conducted on this section, including:
 - Date of survey
 - Methodology used
 - Recorded average speeds
3. Any formal, finalised reports or assessments produced within the last five years that evaluate:
 - Collision patterns
 - Risk levels
 - Road safety concerns
4. The criteria applied when assessing eligibility for fixed or average speed camera enforcement on trunk roads in Wales.
5. Any formal assessment outcome (if available) indicating whether this section has been evaluated against those criteria.

Our Response

The Welsh Government holds some of the information you requested.

- 1) No information held.
- 2) Spreadsheet attached
- 3) No information held - We routinely review personal injury data recorded by the police to identify priorities for investigation which may be considered to be at risk levels. In the 5 year period of this freedom of information request we did not identify high densities of personal injury collisions on the A483 between Welshpool and Newtown so therefore we did not undertake any safety assessments.
- 4) The criteria for fixed and average speed enforcement cameras are set out in the Table at part 5 of this document [Wales Road Casualty Reduction Partnership](#)
- 5) No information held
