Request for Information – ATISN 26829

Information requested

I received your request for information on 25 March. You asked for information about a Compulsory Purchase order on the A465 and specifically you wish to know whether we have acquired a parcel of land from Merthyr Tydfil County Borough Council.

Our response

I requested clarification as to which parcel of land you were referring to but you were unable to provide the plot reference number, so I am unable to provide any further information.

However, as advised previously all Welsh Government CPOs are available on our Welsh Government website along with the schedules with plot reference numbers. The CPOs for the A465, which will be the land in Merthyr Tydfil County Borough Council, will be the ones you are interested in. I have provided links to these CPOs in my responses to your earlier freedom of information requests. They have the reference numbers: ATISN 19540 on 20 May 2024 – this one has direct links to the CPOs on the Welsh Government website, ATISN 20910 on 16 September 2024 and ATISN 23168 on 6 December 2024. Once you have located the plot reference number in the schedules attached to the CPOs which you are interested in, please come back to me.

Next steps

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response. Requests for an internal review should be addressed to the Welsh Government's Freedom of Information Officer at:
