## **Request for Information - ATISN 26970**

Thank you for your request for information dated 12 May. You asked for the following figures for 2023-24, 2024-25 and 2025-26. –

### **1. NHS Wales Executive**

The total annual Welsh Government funding/cost of the NHS Wales Executive. Please also confirm whether the “Welsh Government – Hosted Bodies” figure in Public Health Wales’ accounts is the NHS Wales Executive funding figure.

### **2. Development Bank of Wales**

The total annual Welsh Government funding provided to Development Bank of Wales for its own administration and operating costs, excluding money provided for loans, equity investments, funds under management or other investment activity.

### **3. National Adviser for Violence against Women, Domestic Abuse and Sexual Violence**

The total annual cost to Welsh Government of the National Adviser role/function. For each figure, please state where it is recorded.

## **Our Response**

The Welsh Government holds information related to your requested. Please note that this response only covers that part of the request asking for information on the Development Bank of Wales. The other parts are being allocated elsewhere under separate ATISN numbers and will responded to separately.

The total annual Welsh Government funding provided to Development Bank of Wales for its own administration and operating costs, excluding money provided for loans, equity investments, funds under management or other investment activity was £531,500 in FY 2023-24, £719,537 in FY 2024-25 and £722,084 in FY 2025-26. This funding, provided in the form of Grant-in-Aid, was limited to specific schemes operated by the bank.

With the exception of the direct Grant-in-Aid provisions referenced above, the Development Bank of Wales (DBW) does not receive direct Welsh Government funding to cover administration or day-to-day operating costs. For the most part the Bank’s operations are designed to be financially self-sustaining, with its operating and delivery costs met through fund management and holding fund management fees charged to the funds it manages. These fees are agreed upfront as part of each fund’s design, are transparent, and are regularly benchmarked against market comparators.
