ATISN 26969 - NHS Wales Performance and Improvement

Thank you for your request to Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) received on 12 May 2026, relating to funding for the NHS Wales Executive, now known as NHS Wales Performance and Improvement (NHS P&I).

You requested:

1. The total annual Welsh Government funding/cost of the NHS Wales Executive/NHS P&I for 2023-24, 2024-25 and 2025-26. If final figures are not available, provide the latest budgeted or forecast figure. For each figure, state where it is recorded.
2. Confirm whether the “Welsh Government – Hosted Bodies” figure in Public Health Wales’ accounts is the NHS Wales Executive/ NHS P&I funding figure.

Our Response

NHS Wales Performance and Improvement (previously known as NHS Executive) is a body hosted by Public Health Wales.

Further information on this can be found in the Annual Report for 2024/25 for Public Health Wales – which is available at [Annual report - Public Health Wales](#)

The amount of income that NHS Performance and Improvement received from Welsh Government for 2023/24 and 2024/25 is already in the public domain and disclosed in the annual report under the heading “*Welsh Government – Hosted Bodies*”.

For 2025/26 Welsh Government has provided NHS Wales Performance and Improvement with funding totalling £53.4m.

In line with arrangements across all NHS Wales bodies – Welsh Government directly funds a percentage of the costs of the employer’s pension contributions. The above figure for 2025/26 does not include this amount.

Next Steps
