- Power Factor Correction (PFC) works are a key component of the SLES. Harries Automation & Control Ltd has been Pulse Plastics' long-term supplier for PFC equipment. The existing PFC installation, which they designed, manufactured, and maintain, ensures that the factory's electrical demand maintains a high power factor and complies with network requirements. Although only one quote was received for the PFC installation (from Harries Automation, totaling £16,616.32), the justification provided in the PFC Quote Appraisal document is considered reasonable. The supplier is already contractually responsible for maintaining the system, and the existing equipment is under warranty, meaning the electrical panels cannot be modified by a third party without invalidating that warranty. There is an invoice for earlier works related to the PFC for £9,975.85 (inc. VAT).
- At the time the works commenced, the Grant Offer Letter was still being finalised, so Hebe Rassau 20 Ltd funded the initial solar PV and Power Factor Correction works under the terms of the loan agreement between the two organisations. This explains the invoicing within the claim pack from Hebe Rassau 20 Ltd to Pulse Plastics Limited. There are also corresponding invoices from Inspire Green Ltd to Hebe Rassau 20 Ltd.
- Pulse Plastics is providing 25% match funding, exceeding the 10% minimum required for SMEs. As mentioned, this contribution is being provided by Hebe Rassau 20 Ltd under a formal loan agreement. The arrangement is consistent with guidance that third-party funding may be used. The match funding has been applied to cover the roof strengthening and PFC works (including the invoice for £9,975.85), ensuring that the grant being claimed relates solely to the solar PV system.
- The next phase of the project is to install the battery and energy management systems (300 kW / 1.29 MWh BESS), which has a capital cost of approximately £545,000. The procurement for this phase has already been satisfied.

Based on the above, I believe the claim is valid and all funding preconditions have been met. Pulse Plastics has demonstrated clear value for money in their procurement, provided sufficient evidence of match funding, and ensured that all lease and equipment requirements are satisfied. I am therefore confident that the claim can now be processed.
