### **Information requested**

Thank you for your request for information, under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR), which I received on 28 May 2026. You asked for:

- All statutory environmental obligations to which Welsh Government and/or Welsh Ministers are subject;
- All deadlines relating to these targets or obligations which fall before 7 May 2031.

### **Our response**

Under EIR there is a presumption to release environmental information to the public. In this case it is my understanding that you are requesting information which is already within the public domain.
