Information requested

Thank you for your request which I received on 2 June 2026. You asked for the following:

- a) the cost of the Anti-Racist Wales Action Plan (the Plan) thus far, since its implementation;
- b) whether the Plan supports any charities, and if so, which ones and how much money does it support them with (this could be either through direct donations or contributions via membership of schemes);
- c) whether funding is planned to increase in the coming years.

Our response

The information you requested is enclosed.

a) Cost of the Anti-racist Wales Action Plan (ArWAP) since implementation

The Anti-racist Wales Action Plan is not funded through a single, standalone budget. Delivery is embedded across a range of Welsh Government portfolios, including health, education, housing, social care, employability, and local government. As a result, it is not possible to provide a single overall cost for the Plan.

b) Support for charities

The Anti-racist Wales Action Plan does not provide direct financial support to any specific charity, nor does it make donations or membership contributions to charitable organisations. While some organisations, including charities and third sector bodies, may receive funding through separate Welsh Government programmes that contribute to the delivery of ArWAP objectives, such funding is awarded through the relevant programme arrangements rather than through the Plan itself.

c) Future funding

Future funding will be considered as part of the normal budget planning and spending review processes. Funded programmes across Government will continue to be reviewed in due course as part of the budgetary planning process, taking account of ministerial priorities, available resources and evidence of impact.
