## **Request for Information - ATISN 27053**

### **Information requested**

Does the Welsh Government hold any AIS position data, vessel-tracking data, port-monitoring data or related records for the following vessel and time periods:

Vessel: STENA ESTRID

MMSI: 209878000

IMO: 9807293

Requested time periods:

1. 1 October 2023, 07:00:00 UTC to 11:00:59 UTC
2. 4 October 2023, 19:30:00 UTC to 23:15:59 UTC

Specifically timestamped position records during the Dublin-Holyhead and Holyhead-Dublin crossings, ideally including timestamp, latitude, longitude, speed over ground, course over ground and heading, if held.
