Request for Information - ATISN 27087

Further to your request for information of 12 June where you asked for information about the A40 through Crickhowell. Specifically, you wanted to know:

- 1) On what date did the A40 trunk road through Crickhowell, Powys have a full resurface?
- 2) How much is being spent on the active travel work in Crickhowell, Powys?
- 3) How much would it cost just to resurface the A40 trunk road through Crickhowell, Powys?

Our response

The Welsh Government holds some of the information you have requested.

- 1) November 2005
- 2) The Welsh Government does not hold this information as the Active Travel works are a Powys County Council scheme funded through the regional Mid Wales Corporate Joint Committee. - 3) Resurfacing work on the A40 in Crickhowell for the town and urban area is planned for this year, 2026, at a cost of £1.27m.
