### **Information requested**

Thank you for your request which I received on 17 June 2026. You asked for information held by the Welsh Government regarding cloud seeding activities.

### **Our response**

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you require is not held by the Welsh Government.

Cloud seeding is a form of atmospheric or weather modification and is not devolved to the Welsh Government and as such we hold no information within the scope of this request.
