##### **FEED ADDITIVES**

Determination of authorisation status: authorisation of a preparation of *Saccharomyces cerevisiae* CNCM I-1079 as a feed additive for calves (for rearing and for fattening), all other ruminant species (for rearing and for fattening), and camelidae (for rearing and for fattening)

##### **Explanatory note**

*(this note is not part of the determination)*

This determination is made in relation to Wales by the Welsh Ministers in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 9 of Regulation [\(EC\) No 1831/2003](#) of the European Parliament and of the Council on additives for use in animal nutrition (EUR 2003/1831).

It authorises the use of a preparation of *Saccharomyces cerevisiae* CNCM I-1079, belonging to the additive category 'zootechnical additives' and to the functional group 'gut flora stabilisers', as a feed additive for calves (for rearing and for fattening), all other ruminant species (for rearing and for fattening), and camelidae (for rearing and for fattening). The terms of the authorisation and the conditions upon which the feed additive is authorised are set out in the Schedule.

There has been consultation as required by Article 9 of Regulation [\(EC\) No 178/2002](#) of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down the general principles and requirements of food law, establishing the European Food Safety Authority and laying down procedures in matters of food safety (EUR 2002/178).

The preparation of *Saccharomyces cerevisiae* CNCM I-1079 is already authorised as a feed additive for:

- chickens for fattening and for minor poultry species for fattening;
- all pigs other than weaned piglets and sows and all minor porcine species
- piglets and sows; and
- turkeys for fattening.

The authorisations of the preparation for these uses and the terms and conditions upon which they are authorised, as they had effect on 31 March 2025, continue to have effect pursuant to regulation 23 (savings and transitional provision: general) of the Food and Feed (Regulated Products) (Amendment, Revocation, Consequential and Transitional Provision) Regulations 2025 and are detailed on the [Feed Additive Register](#).

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## Determination

### Application and coming into force

1. This determination applies in relation to Wales, and comes into force on 13<sup>th</sup> October 2025.

### Interpretation

1. Any expression used both in this determination and in Regulation (EC) No 1831/2003 of the European Parliament and of the Council on additives for use in animal nutrition (EUR 2003/1831) has the same meaning as it has in that Regulation.

### Determination of authorisation status of *Saccharomyces cerevisiae* CNCM I-1079

2. The preparation of *Saccharomyces cerevisiae* CNCM I-1079 specified in the Schedule, belonging to the additive category 'zootechnical additives' and to the functional group 'gut flora stabilisers', is authorised as an additive in animal nutrition in Wales, subject to the conditions and requirements set out in the Schedule.
