Thank you for your request for information, received on 30 April 2026, in which you asked for information relating to the Curriculum for Wales grant support programme, specifically the grant awarded to STEM Learning UK for the project “Teaching Digital with Confidence (CFWGSP-82)”.

You requested information on delivery against year 1 targets as at 31 March 2026, including information on courses and resources developed, advisors and facilitators recruited, professional learning delivered, engagement of schools and practitioners (including priority groups), participation in networks, and evaluation of professional learning activity.

Your request has been processed in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000. Our response is outlined below. Where relevant, we have contextualised the information using targets current as of 31 March 2026, which include amendments agreed by STEM Learning and the Welsh Government. The table provided within Annex A, shows indicators of changes authorised through a variation of terms, along with details from the original application prior to the FOI request. These modifications are documented in the table.

Information disclosed

We are able to disclose information we hold relating to STEM Learning’s progress against relevant targets and associated spend as at 31 March 2026. Our responses to your questions are set out below. The information within Annex A is based on recorded information held by the Welsh Government at the time your request was received. Where we did not hold recorded information for a particular part of your request at that time, this is indicated accordingly.

The information requested includes the names of individuals employed by STEM Learning in connection with the grant-funded project. Where such names appear in the information held, they have been redacted under section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. Annex B contains the decision and its accompanying explanation.
