Thank you for your request which I received on 29 May. You asked for the following:

 - its current risk rating, score or assessment (where recorded); and
 - the responsible policy area.
3. Copies of any briefing notes, submissions or reports produced since 11 May 2026 relating to the management or mitigation of those risks.
4. Any correspondence sent by senior officials to ministers since 11 May which discusses risks to the delivery of government priorities.
